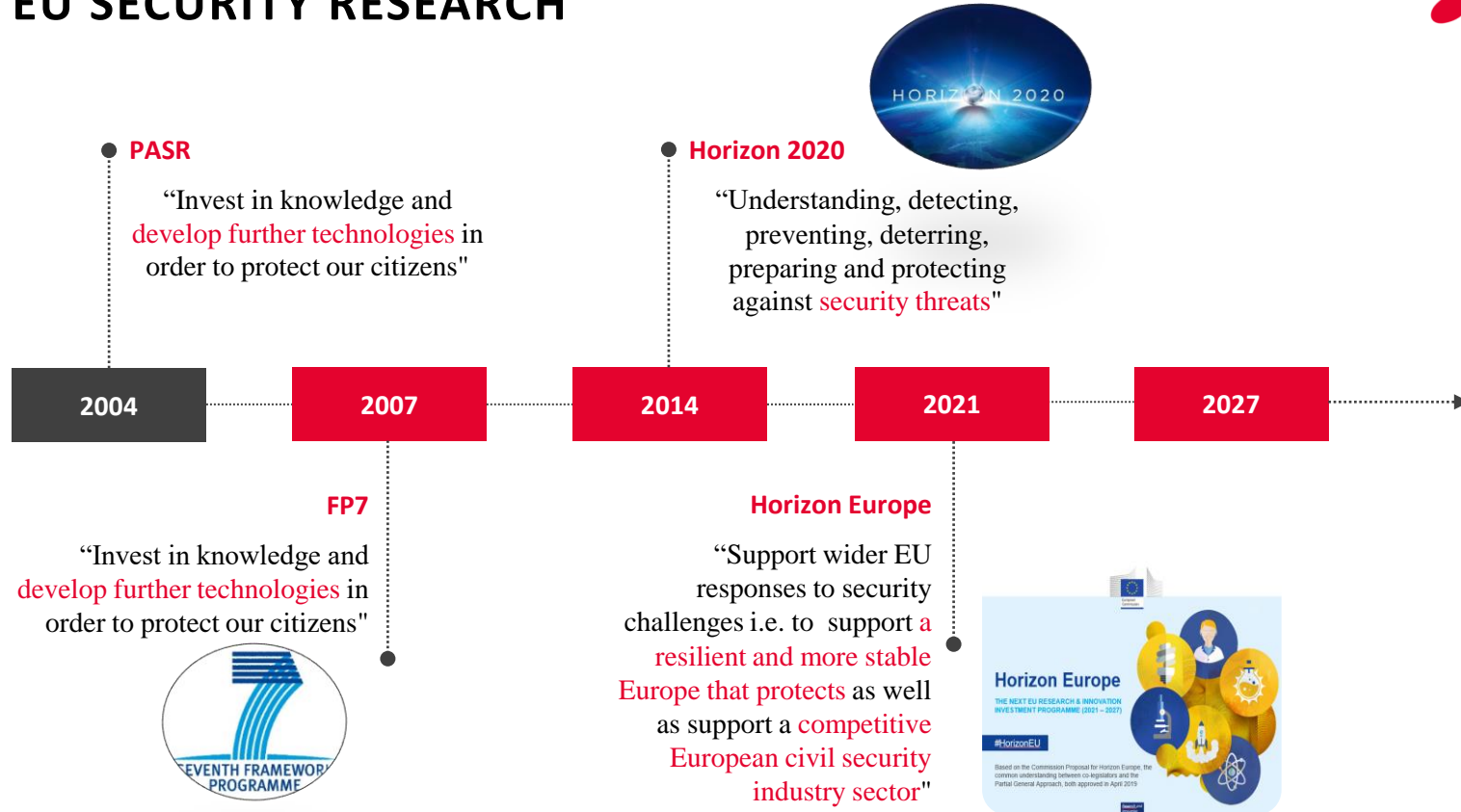

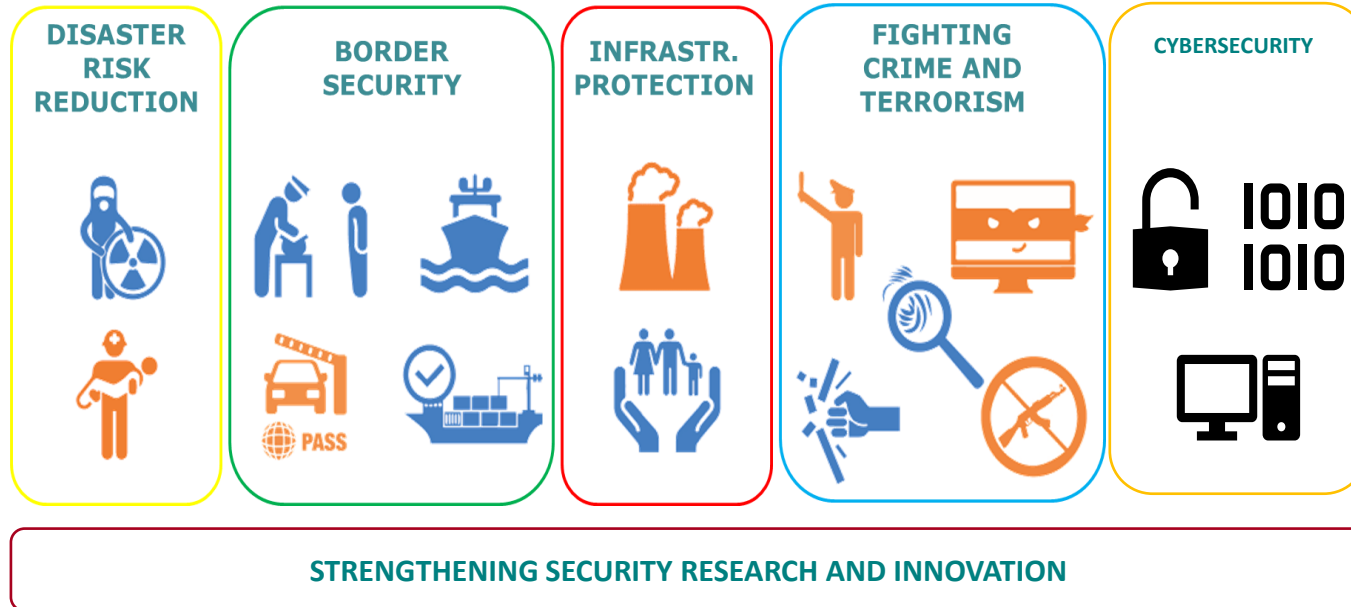
EU SECURITY UNION STRATEGY

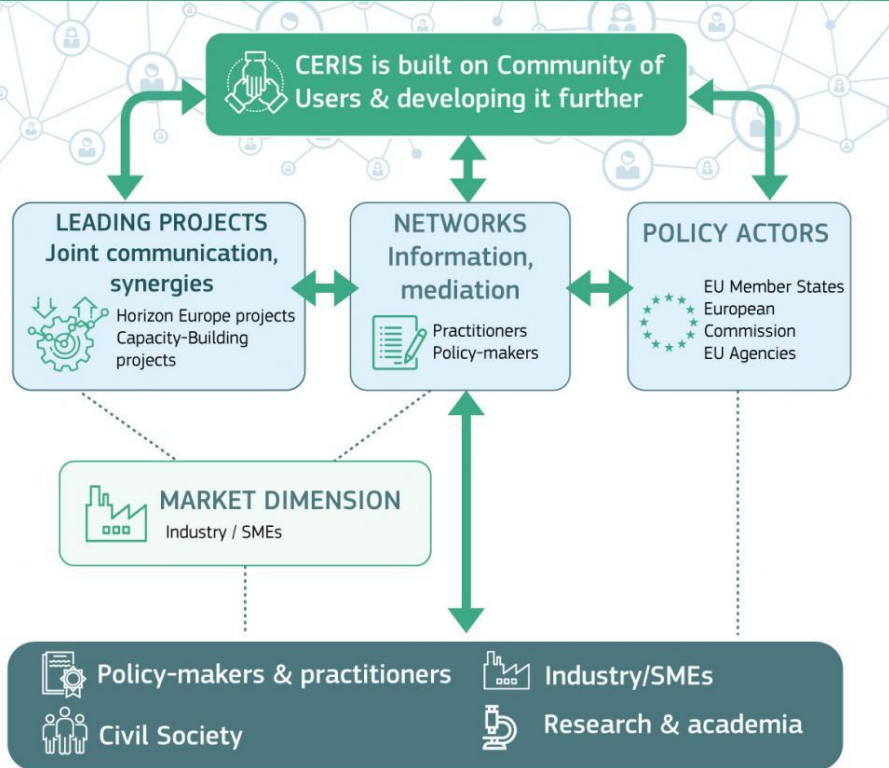
- Security Research as a building block

IMPACT AREAS OF SECURITY RESEARCH

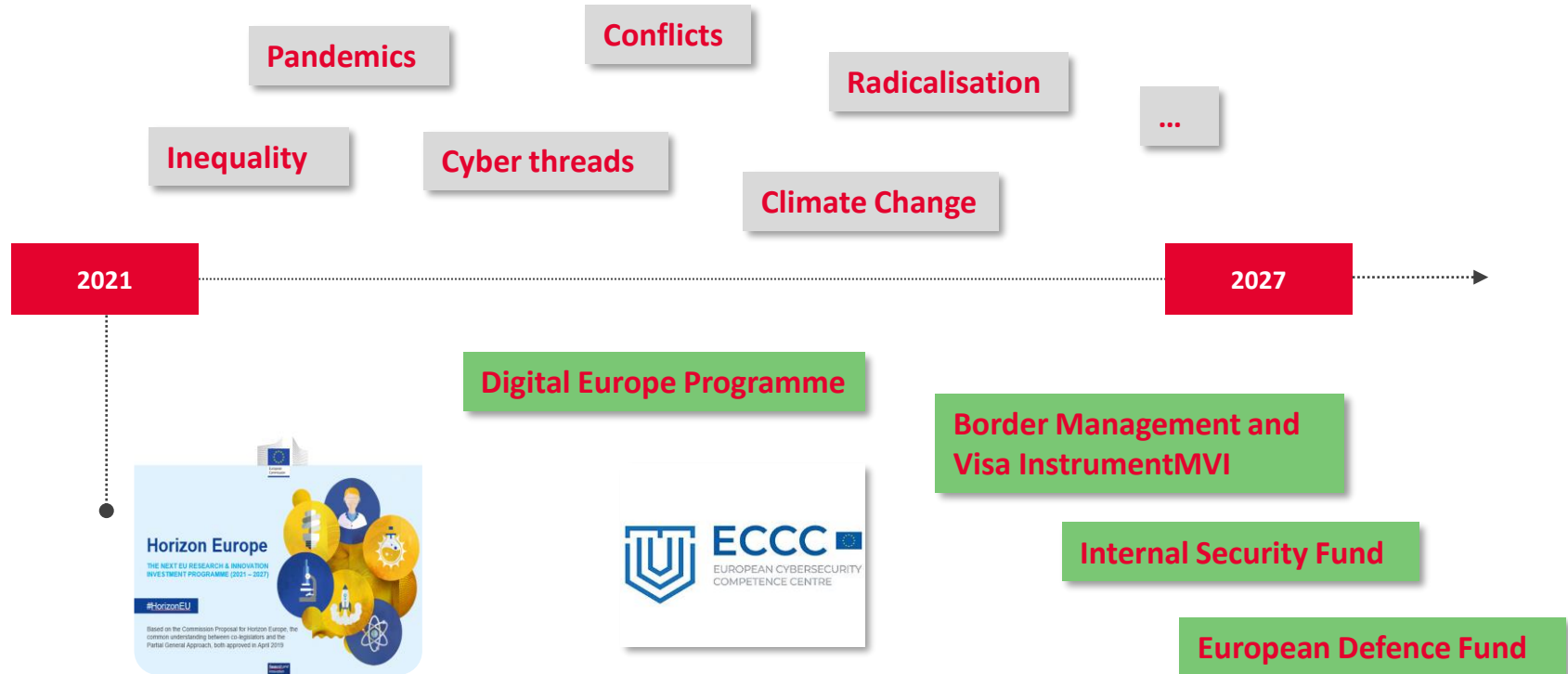




COMMUNITY FOR EUROPEAN RESEARCH AND INNOVATION FOR SECURITY (CERIS).
