1. 21st Century: Industrial revolution (Industry 4.0), digitalisation in society; we are all online (mobile devices, social media, home office, home banking, energy management, etc.)
2. T-RD&I developments in MSs ; Smart Cities, Intelligence and Law Enforcement Community, Defence (training, data driven analyses, operations, cyber crime, manipulation of information)
3. “ New generation with new capabilities and capacities” : The HR factor and its potential
4. Transposition of T-RD&I good practises and experience in MS to CSDP Missions and Headquarters: Modernisation of CSDP
